Conferences in 2023

The meeting, held by the International Civil Aviation Organization's (ICAO) South American (SAM) office in Santiago de Chile, brought together representatives from civil aviation authorities, airlines, airport operators, and other industry stakeholders. The themes of RAAC 17 were "Harmonizing Safety in the Pan-American Region" and "Sustainable Aviation", focusing on the implementation of the Global Aviation Safety Plan, the use of safety data for decision-making, and the integration of unmanned aircraft systems (UAS) into the airspace. The outcomes of the meeting will be used to inform future safety initiatives and policies in the region. >

Pioneering Aviation Safety: New Software Enhancements within EMPIC-EAP®

At EMPIC GmbH, we're excited to announce our latest plans and future roadmap, enhancing THE safety oversight management solution for aviation regulators.

By the end of 2023, we're launching an **Occurrence Reporting** module for our ICAO clients. This innovative module will manage the entire lifecycle of safety-related occurrences, streamlining the reporting and resolution process. In addition to the API for external reporting embedded in our WEB Server, this module will also receive a WEB Form option in 2024.

For our EASA clients, we're developing an interface for the ECCAIRS E2 database, set to roll out as soon as EASA publishes an API. This will ensure efficient data exchange and improved safety oversight. Our many EASA clients are impatiently awaiting this enhancement, as it will considerably increase their efficiency.

Future enhancements of our OAS module will include "**cross-domain auditing**" to enable comprehensive audits across multiple operational areas, our "**Master Surveillance Plan**" as a strategic tool to help develop a risk-based approach to safety oversight. The MSP will support three main planning components: (1.) frequency of visits (2.) distribution of available resources, and (3.) content of oversight, including focus areas.

Finally, the feature of recording the **Statement of Compliance** (SoC) per service provider will allow the regulator to create tailored oversight programs that only include the relevant elements of the regulation that are related to the specific service provider's activities!

After subject matter experts have checked the SoC for consistency, the system can align the regulatory requirements spelled out in oversight programs and checklists against it. A new version of the SoC may be required after the service provider submits a change application or if the regulation is amended, which in turn leads to a re-alignment of checklists. The system stores all reasons for adjustments in detail so that the resulting scope of surveillance is traceable throughout its lifecycle. The advantages for the regulator are faster planning, shorter checklists, and more accurate reporting, while evidence on compliance is recorded with the statement.

At EMPIC, we're committed to driving innovation in aviation safety oversight. As the industry evolves, we'll continue to deliver robust, cutting-edge software solutions to ensure the highest levels of safety and efficiency.
